Renewal of the SNETP Governing Board

The Governing Board of SNETP is to be renewed periodically. The Chair of the outgoing Board consults the General Assembly with a proposed list of candidates for the new Board.

The open procedure for expressing interest to be a member of the second Governing Board was opened for 2 months from 14 September to 13 November 2009, available on the Platform website and communicated to SNETP members. 31 candidates have expressed their will to sit on the new Board. At its 5th meeting on 27 November 2009, the outgoing Board decided to accept all candidates on the list to be proposed to the General Assembly. Good balance is achieved between industry (12 candidates), research (12), complemented by European bodies and TSOs (7).
